**10TH ANNIVERSARY OF  
THE KAZAKHSTAN BRANCH OF THE  
M.V. LOMONOSOV MOSCOW STATE UNIVERSITY**

In October 2011 10th anniversary of the Kazakhstan Branch of the M.V. Lomonosov Moscow State University is celebrated. In these ten years the Kazakhstan Branch has become one of important centres of scientific and educational system of Kazakhstan.

In this Branch mathematical direction plays a special role. Its graduates are high qualified specialists in mathematics and information technologies. Both directions are supervised by the world recognized research and educational centres: the Faculty of Mechanics and Mathematics and the Faculty of Computational Mathematics and Cybernetics of the Moscow State University. In years 1 – 2 students are studying in Astana, and the leading specialists of those faculties come to Astana and give main lecture courses. Studying at final years is going on at the Moscow State University, where also the students' diploma dissertations are examined.

Following traditions of the Moscow State University students start early their own research under supervision of well-known scientists from the Moscow State University and its Kazakhstan Branch. As a result many of them successfully continue their postgraduate studies in Russia, Kazakhstan (PhD programme), the USA, the UK, France, Sweden, etc.

Teaching of students of specialities “Mathematics” and “Applied Mathematics and Informatics” is carried out by the Department of mathematics and informatics. Well-known mathematicians and talented young scientists work there: a winner of the State prize, a member of the National Academy of Sciences of Kazakhstan, Professor M. Otelbaev; the head of Department of mathematics and informatics, a winner of the K.I. Satpaev award, Professor E.D. Nursultanov; young scientist, a winner of the D.A. Kunaev award, Doctor of Sciences K.A. Bekmaganbetov. Some graduates of the department are now its members. Among them are A.N. Vasil'ev and A.K. Abdikalykov, winners of international mathematical olympiads. Recently they were students, but they have already obtained serious scientific results published in well-known rating journals: “Doklady of Russian Academy of Sciences” and “Mathematical notes”.

The Editorial Board of the Eurasian Mathematical Journal congratulates the Kazakhstan Branch of the Moscow State University with the 10th anniversary and, in particular, its Department of mathematics and informatics, and wishes them continued creative success in research and education for the sake of Kazakhstan and Russia.
